Thank you for participating in Square Wave! In order to prepare you well, you will find in this document all the relevant information to make it a great afternoon.

improvisation

This afternoon you will participate four times in free improvisations, each lasting ten minutes. We'll do a total of four rounds of four duos every round. Matching of the duos will be done by drawing lots. Each duo will also be assigned a BPM (tempo) by drawing lots. This BPM will be within the range of 70-140bpm. So fate determines who you improvise with and what the tempo is. We use a central clock (SQUARE WAVE) to connect your system with that of your improvisation partner.

clock sync and audio

Everyone receives a central clock and a central reset signal. Note: You cannot use your own internal clock! The central clock signal comes from the ALM017 / Pamela's NEW Workout module and is connected to your system via one (clock) or two (clock + reset) mini-jack (s) / 3.5mm audio plugs. So make sure you have at least an analog clock input to receive the SQUARE WAVE for synchronizing the tempo. A PA is present. You can choose whether you want to use mono (1 cable) or stereo (2 cables) out to the PA. Connecting to the mixing table is done with large (6.5 mm) jack cables. Please bring (a) cable(s) of 5 meters or longer to connect your system to the PA.

practical information

This event is aimed at users of modular synthesizers (Eurorack, Buchla, Serge, MOTM, Moog, etc). You can take your system with you both patched and unpatched. Do what you think is the best / nicest / most convenient / most exciting. You have 10 minutes to turn every improvisation with your partner into something beautiful. The location is on the 2nd floor of a beautiful but old building without a lift. It is better to leave heavy or large instruments at home. The location is in the city center, within walking distance of NS (railway) Station Deventer. Parking is available nearby in the Brink Garage (paid). We put the synthesizers / gear as close together as possible, to promote interaction during improvisations. Every participant has approximately 1 square meter available to install his / her things. Every participant receives one 220v power hookup. Please bring your own sockets / extension cords if you need more power hookups. Participation is on a voluntary basis. No reimbursement is available.

The connection of the clock, reset and audio connections of all participants is done before the doors open for visitors. Experience shows that we really need the time to set that up. Therefore make sure that you are present at 12:00hrs. Any questions or suggestions? Please contact us. Together we make it a super synth afternoon!
